



# Dress Code

*This revised uniform code will be fully implemented by the start of 2009*

## SCHOOL DRESS CODE

The wearing of uniform is a compulsory part of student life at Wanganui Park Secondary College. Students who for any reason are out of uniform must bring an explanatory note signed by their parent/guardian to their Home Group teacher. Good secondhand uniforms are sometimes available at school. Assistance may be available through the Student Welfare Coordinator. Discussions are confidential.

### Girls

#### **Summer Uniform**

White tailored shirt with collar or white polo shirt with twin bottle-green stripes on collar and WPSC emblem.

Plain short-sleeved white T-shirt may be worn underneath Bottle-green tailored shorts

Green check dress – princess style

Parents may make a dress provided it is princess style with set-in sleeves and a turn back collar of self material.

Dress must be of an appropriate length

White socks. Plain black lace-up shoes or black or brown sandals. Sandals must not be slip on i.e. they must have a back. (Note: Sandals are alternative footwear and are not permitted in some classes for safety reasons.)

#### **Winter Uniform**

Black Watch tartan kilt or bottle green tailored slacks. Kilt must be of appropriate length.

White tailored shirt with collar or white polo shirt with twin bottle-green stripes on collar and WPSC emblem

Plain short-sleeved white T-shirt may be worn underneath Black socks or black stocking or tights or white socks

Plain black lace-up shoes (no platform or high heels).

### Boys

#### **Summer Uniform**

Bottle-green polo shirt with twin white stripes on collar and WPSC emblem

Plain short-sleeved white T-shirt may be worn underneath Plain grey shorts no longer than to the knees (a small label on the back pocket is acceptable)

Black socks or white socks

Plain black lace-up shoes or brown or black sandals. Sandals must not be slip on i.e. they must have a back.

(Note: Sandals are alternative footwear and are not permitted in some classes because of safety reasons.)

#### **Winter Uniform**

Bottle-green polo shirt with twin white stripes on collar and WPSC emblem

Plain short-sleeved white T-shirt may be worn underneath Grey trousers – “SCAGGS 720’s” or Max Dax

Black socks or plain white socks

Plain black lace up shoes

### All Year Garments

For both boys and girls, for all seasons:

#### **Jumper/Jacket**

A choice of any one or more of the following items:

- the WPSC bottle-green wool jumper with bands in the school colours of tan and royal blue
- the WPSC bottle-green tekfleece jacket (Gondwana)
- the WPSC shower/windproof jacket
- the WPSC windcheater

**NOTE:** The WPSC “tekfleece” jacket can be fitted and ordered from Camping World, Wyndham St, Shepparton. There is to be no embroidery on this jacket unless authorised by the school for particular groups

#### **Jewellery**

Limited jewellery is permitted. Students should not wear jewellery that may be deemed unsafe in Technology classes. Certain jewellery may be banned at the Principal’s discretion.

#### **Hats**

Brimmed hats are compulsory in terms 1 and 4 at Wanganui Park. Students may select their own brimmed hat providing it shades their face.

#### **Sports Uniforms**

A uniform for Physical Education and Sport is compulsory for Years 7 to 11 and consists of:

- Bottle green shorts
- College white polo short or plain white polo shirt
- Navy microfibre track pants

Students may arrive or leave school in this uniform if they have PE period 1 or 6 respectively.

#### **Dance Uniforms**

A uniform for Dance is compulsory for Years 8 to 11 students involved in Dance units and consists of:

- Black leggings
- Black spandex T-shirt or black T-shirt

All uniform requirements are available at the School Uniform Shop and GV School Uniforms.

The Gondwana tekfleece jackets are available at Camping World and should be fitted and ordered during Term 1.

**If in doubt about the acceptability of any item of uniform, check with the school before buying.**
